

## **Executive Order 2017-13**

**WHEREAS**, North Dakota has taken a proactive stance toward energy development fostering innovative, long-term energy strategies to meet the growing state and national demand in an environmentally responsive manner; and,

WHEREAS, in the EmPower commission was established by the sixtieth legislative assembly, to monitor issues pertinent to the state's comprehensive energy policy and make recommendations to the energy policy as needed; and,

WHEREAS, the EmPower commission is composed of the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and representatives appointed by the Governor from North Dakota's energy industries; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Governor is authorized to appoint additional nonvoting members to the EmPower Commission; and,

**WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Governor Sanford has valuable prior experience as a proactive local leader and business owner in one of our state's largest oil producing counties; and,

WHEREAS, as President of the N.D. Senate, the Lieutenant Governor understands the important tax, workforce, environmental and quality of life policy issues related to an "all-of-the-above-energy" development approach.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Doug Burgum, Governor of the State of North Dakota, hereby appoints Lieutenant Governor Brent Sanford to serve as a nonvoting member of the EmPower commission pursuant to North Dakota Century Code § 17-07-01 (n).

This order is issued upon the following basis and for the following reasons:

- 1. The Governor is vested with the executive authority pursuant to Article V of the North Dakota Constitution; and,
- 2. The Governor is authorized sto appoint additional nonvoting members to the EmPower commission under North Dakota Century Code §17-07-01 (n).

This order is effective immediately and will continue indefinitely.
