WHEREAS, the observance of Maternal Mental Health Awareness Week encourages North Dakotans to raise awareness and increase the understanding of perinatal mood disorders to reduce stigma attached to receiving treatment; and to recognize mothers and families who have experienced perinatal mood disorders and to encourage early treatment and interventions.
