PROCLAMATION

GIVING HEARTS DAY FEBRUARY 8, 2024

WHEREAS, Giving Hearts Day was started in 2008 by Dakota Medical Foundation and Impact Foundation as the first 24-hour giving event of its kind in the region, with the Alex Stern Family Foundation joining as a co-host in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Giving Hearts Day is a gateway for North Dakota citizens and beyond to connect to charitable organizations doing important work improving health and quality of life across North Dakota; and

WHEREAS, Dakota Medical Foundation, Impact Foundation and the Alex Stern Family Foundation jointly support the Impact Institute to dramatically improve "fund-raising" efforts of nonprofit organizations by equipping them with data-driven resources, training and coaching; and


WHEREAS, last year, more than 42,000 caring donors gave more than 90,000 gifts to nearly 560 charities totaling \$26.1 million, and since inception, Giving Hearts Day has raised more than \$165 million to support regional charities; and

WHEREAS, Giving Hearts Day 2024 includes more than 600 nonprofit organizations and spans the entire state of North Dakota and northwestern Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Giving Hearts Day has set a bold goal to build the most generous region in the nation by 2025, supporting North Dakota in becoming the No. 1 state for volunteerism and donated goods and making Giving Hearts Day the No. 1 giving day in the nation.


NOW, THEREFORE, as Governor of the State of North Dakota, I do hereby proclaim
